



Pilot Study:

LGBTQIA+ Caregiver Social Support

About this study

This study aims to learn more about the physical activity habits of **LGBTQIA+ people who provide care for loved ones living with Alzheimer's Disease or other forms of dementia**. Further understanding these habits and social networks will aid development of programs to help caregivers and improve patient outcomes.

You may be eligible if you:

- Are a primary caregiver of a person living with Alzheimer's Disease or other other forms of dementia
- Identify as a sexual or gender minority (i.e., LGBTQIA+).
- Are at least 18 years of age

What's involved?

This study involves completing a guided survey on Zoom with a member of the research team. This interview would last less than one hour.

Prior to starting, you would fill out a short survey including basic information about you (age, gender, race, ethnicity). We would then talk to you about your role as a caregiver of someone with dementia and the network of people who support you.

We would ask you to provide contact information for up to 5 people in your network to complete a follow up survey. For completing this survey, they would receive a \$25 gift card.

Participation in this research study is voluntary. If you decide participate in this research, you will receive a \$75 Amazon e-gift card upon completing your interview.
